Emails from Cousins

Related to the Queen? First, I want to thank Carlise Moncrief for her donation to the First Baptist Church of Americus, GA in memory of my deceased brother George Leroy Peele. Carlise has always been supportive of our efforts. Next, I want to thank her for sharing her connection to Queen Elizabeth II and since many of you are related to this line, it may be a surprise to you! This is Carlise's Christmas present to the Peel line down south and elsewhere. It is best portrayed in a chart so here is my attempt to add to what Carlise sent.

While there are other lines which merged into the Peelle family, I added the Jossey and Peelle lines to the chart for interest of those who may be from one of these lines. These two lines in the chart merge with the 1753 marriage of Robert Peelle (1730-1808) to Margaret B. Jossey (1732-1796). See the first two columns. Their son is John Jossey Peel(le).

Then the next two lines merge with the 1799 marriage of John Jossey Peel(le) (1777-1844) to Elizabeth Woodard (1778-1859). If you are a descendent from this marriage, then trace your line back up the Woodard line in the third column through the common ancestor **Christopher Woodard** and down the last column to the Queen of England.

How many of you are kin to the Queen? My data base shows that 639 of you are related as direct descendants of John Jossey Peel and Elizabeth Woodard. The youngest I have is Gray Woodard McDaniel, born in 1993, son of John Woodard McDaniel and his wife Katherine Sims Marshall. Now does that make you feel Royal? I wish I was related.

There is an interesting article on John Jossey Peel on pages 205-207 of the Peele Chronicles. It seems that he moved from Edgecombe County, NC to Troop County, GA, under some duress

over indebtedness but not at his fault. I sent a translated copy of the court transcripts to Carlise for her review. Thanks Carlise for this great information.

John David Peele? My next email of great significance started with an email from Andrew David Peele, sent Monday, November 03, 2014.

Mr. Horace Peele,

Greetings. My name is Andrew David Peele. I am researching my Peele line and am trying to find the link to the main body of Peeles in the USA. I am derived from the Outer Banks Peele family and the earliest person my sister Kim Phillips (Peele) and I have been able to link is John Flowers Peele (DOB-1804?).

I have read through Volume 12 Issue 2 of your online newsletter (<http://www.peele.info/lawrence/Volume%2012%20Issue%202.pdf>) and also have found a website (<http://www.geni.com/people/John-Peele/600000009665057070>) on Geni.com that states the father of John Flowers is John Andrew Peele, whose father was John David Peele.

Don't know the truth of this mystery. I see that some DNA testing has been conducted. If testing is not complete or conclusive and if you need another (potential) Peele for testing, I am happy to do so!

Thank you for any help you can offer. I have contacted you before; it's been at least 10+ years. I now have three children of my own. How time flies!

I checked my data base again and found that I have John Flowers "Jack" Peele (1804-1881) as the son of Andrew Peele (1781-1811) whose father is a John Peele who died in Currituck Co., before May of 1803, his wife's name was Julia. My records on this line were contributed by others and I have no John David Peele at all. Then I immediately visited the two sites which Andrew listed and much to my surprise, I found major errors in the genealogy of the family.

Robert Peele and Elizabeth Edgerton are my family and they have no son named John David Peele. So, Andrew, NO we are not related and therefore the connection that you have found on Geni.com is not true, it is an error. Also, actual Rich Square Quaker records shown on page 133 of the ***Peele Chronicles*** do not support this name. It is rather a failure by someone to do proper research. But in reading the above entry for a John David Peele, it shows a higher level of error other than just having your ancestor subordinated to our main Peele/Peele line. The above picture implies that the entry is Daughter of the American Revolution (DAR) approved, that is not true either. The DAR only list a David Peele with the dates of 1751-1803, no John David Peele and no date range of 1751-1807.

Our lines are also proven NOT to be connected through DNA. There is no proven relation between the Outer Bank Peeles and the mainline Peele family. If you are new to the newsletter, we started articles on DNA in the 2012 newsletters. With the help of Susie Wood and Don Kincaid, we had the DNA sample from a member of the Outer Banks Peele line, one **Mr. Michael Oden Peele** submitted. The results came back in January 2013 and we learned that Michael Oden Peele is not related to our line of the Peele family.

In comparing **Y-DNA37** markers, which show **10 mismatches**, the probability that **(256680) Michael Oden Peele** and **(220264) Horace Bullard Peele** shared a common ancestor within the last 4 generations is 0.00%, within the last 8 generations is 0.01%, and within the last 12 generations is 0.20%, all less than one percent chance. Since I am the 12th generation from Lawrence Peele, there is no chance the Michael is my blood-line cousin, at least not from Lawrence.

Errors on Geni.com. In previous newsletters, I have published articles to highlight errors that I have found. Now we shall do it again but this time I will show examples and list those who have made the errors. The hopes are that you, the reader, will know some of these people and assist in getting their records straight.

There are fifty-one "Smart Matches" or references to David Peele with some combination of the dates 1751 – 1807 on the Geni.com site. Of these, most are wrong, several are just incomplete. I found three that had the correct dates and understood that there are two Davids. Although I must admit that I do not know which David the others were trying to document since most have them combined. Arlene Murphy has the most incorrect entries, at least twelve.

Two David Peelles. There are two Davids, one born in 1751 and another born in 1754. David-1751 married Mary Woodard and died in 1803 in Duplin County. David-1754 married Betsy Fletcher and died in 1807 in Wayne County, NC. The parents of the David-1751 are Robert Peelle 1709-1782 and Charity Dickenson. The parents of David-1754 are Robert Peelle 1730-1808 and wife Margaret B. Jossey. Robert Peelle-1730 is the son of Robert Peelle-1709. In other words, Father and son both had a David. David-1751 is the half uncle to David-1754. There are forty-eight entries on Geni.com carrying David as 1751-1807 and many with the wrong county for birth and death. **There is no David 1751-1807.**

David Peelle-1751. The error found on Geni.com is exacerbated by the publication of the book titled "**Order of First Families of North Carolina Ancestor Biographies Vol. 1**", short title "The First Two Hundred" by John A. Brayton. On pages 156-157, Brayton lists all the children correctly for Robert Peelle-1709 and his two wives, Elizabeth Edgerton and Charity Dickinson, a total of fourteen (14) children. But Brayton associated the wrong wife and death date to David-1751, he makes the following entry in reference to the children of Robert Peelle IV and his second wife Charity Dickinson, listing the sixth child of Robert as follows:

- [6] f. **David Peelle**, born 10.10.1751, died testate 4.25.1807, Contentnea Monthly Meeting, his will proved Feb 1808, Wayne Co., NC, Will Book B, p.416; married 2.9.1794, Contentnea Monthly Meeting, **Priscilla Fletcher**, who died testate between 9 Nov 1807 and July 1808, Wayne Co., NC, RD-1, p.88. David Peelle, on 4-7-1773, Rich Square Monthly Meeting, requested a certificate to join Contentnea Monthly Meeting.

The only thing correct above is that David was born 10.10.1751 as documented in the actual Rich Square records shown on page 133 of the **Peelle Chronicles**. The rest of Brayton's entry belongs to David-1754, my direct line. David-1754 is my great great great Grandfather.

David Peelle-1751 is listed in the 1790 census in Dobbs County with two males over sixteen years, two males under sixteen, two females and three slaves. In 1801 David Peelle-1751 bought 500 acres on the North East Branch of the Cape Fear River in Duplin County, NC from Nathaniel Price. His estate was inventoried on 20 April 1803 (Recorded by Bryan Minshew, Administrator, Duplin County, NC, Pleas and Quarters Sessions, Part 5, 1798-1803, Page 89.) and divided in 1804 (Duplin County, NC, Division of Land, Book A, Page 6.). Bryan Minshew, Administrator, named above is related to David's youngest son John Peal's wife, Patricia Minshew. Here is David's family:

Descendants of David Peelle-1751

1. **David⁶ Peelle** (Robert⁵, Robert⁴, Robert³, Robert², Lawrence¹) was born 10 Oct 1751 Near Rich Square, Northampton Co., NC¹, and died Apr 1803 and is buried in Mt Olive, Duplin Co., NC². He married **Mary "Molly" Woodard** Abt. 1778 in (Greene Co., NC?), daughter of Thomas Woodard and Lydia Langston. She was born 1754 in Rich Square, Northampton, NC³, and died Aft. 1791 in Wayne Co., Near Mt Olive, NC.

Children of David Peelle and Mary Woodard are:

- 2 i. Zilpha⁷ Peelle, born Abt. 1780.
- 3 ii. Robert Peelle, born Abt. 1785 in (Never Married)⁴; died 1811.
- 4 iii. Patsy Peelle, born Abt. 1788. She married Bryan Minshew; born Abt. 1788.
- 5 iv. John Peal, born 27 Mar 1791 in Indian Springs, Dobbs Co., NC⁴; died 18 Aug 1848 in

Indian Springs, Wayne Co., NC⁵. He married Patricia "Patty" Minshew 11 Nov 1815 in Wayne Co., NC⁶; born 1790 in Wayne Co., NC; died 1856 in Indian Springs, Wayne Co., NC.

Many genealogists have David-1751, son of Robert-1709, and David-1754, the son of Robert-1730, as the same person and some have him with two wives. There are several problems trying to combine these families.

Mary Woodard, wife of David-1751 did not have any children after 1791, having died soon thereafter. Conversely, David-1754 and Priscilla did not have their first child James until 1794 and their last child Fletcher Peelle was born in 1805, long after David-1751 had died since his estate was settled in 1803. Priscilla names all of her children in her will, written in 1807.

David Peelle-1754. Robert Peelle-1730 and his wife, Margaret B.Jossey, had twelve children. Margaret was a descendant of immigrant James Jossey, Gentleman, born in London, who came to Nansemond County, Virginia, about 1640. Robert and Margaret had been sharing their land with their sons with two deeds of gift recorded before Margaret died. After Margaret died in 1796, Robert started dividing more land between his other sons. There are at least five deeds recorded where he sold/gave his land with his sons.

Robert gave his sons Willis and David adjoining lands where they settled and lived until they died. David Peelle-1754 lived with his father in Northampton County until 07 April 1773 when he and his father both requested a certificate of transfer from Rich Square MM to Great Contentnea MM in Dobbs County, NC. Robert-1730 purchased land in Dodds County, which later became Wayne County when it was formed in 1779. That land included two tracts forming 220 acres where David and Priscilla raised their family. David received the land from his father by a Deed of Gift in 1790. A full text copy of the deed is shown on pages 152-153 of the ***Peele Chronicles***. Here is a partial extract.

Robert's Deed of Gift to David

To all people to whom these presents shall come know ye that I, Robert Peele, of Edgecomb County in the State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the love and good will that I bear unto my son David Peele of the County of Wayne and State Aforesaid and for other good causes me hereunto moving have given granted alienated conveyed and confirmed unto my said son David Peele his heirs and assigns forever one certain messuage tract piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the said County of Wayne and on Bear Creek it being part of the lands I bought of Henry Howell by a deed bearing date of seventh day of January One Thousand Seven Hundred and

Eighty six and also the lands I bought of Randolph Branch by a deed bearing date the Seventh day of the fourth month One thousand seven hundred and eighty six is supposed to contain two hundred and twenty acres be the same more or less and being the land whereon the said David Peele now dwells [Text eliminated for space]

End of Deed of Gift

David married **Priscilla Fletcher (1771-1807)**, daughter of Joshua Fletcher (1734) and Sarah [Fletcher] (1740) on 9 February 1794 at the Great Contentnea MM in Wayne County, NC. They raised four children from 1794 to 1805. This was a tragic family, and unfortunately it is my direct line. Something makes me think that David had some sort of lingering sickness based upon these factors:

- His father gave him the land on which he lived.
- He did not get married until he was 40 years of age.
- He wrote his will seven years before his death.

In those days, most wills were written when a person was almost on his/her death bed, usually a few days or a month or so before. When David wrote his will in 1800, his oldest son James was only six years old, Polly was four, and Priscilla was three months pregnant with our great-great-grandfather, Robert. Both David and Priscilla died in 1807, age 53 and 36 respectively. They had the shortest life spans of any of my ancestors. They left four young orphaned children, James - 13, Polly - 12, Robert - 6, and Fletcher less than 2.

Descendants of David Peelle-1754

1. David⁷ Peelle (Robert⁶, Robert⁵, Robert⁴, Robert³, Robert², Lawrence¹) was born 1754 in Northampton Co., NC¹, and died 25 Apr 1807 in Wayne Co., NC². He married **Priscilla Fletcher** 09 Feb 1794 in Contentnea MH, Wayne Co., NC³, daughter of Joshua Fletcher and Sarah [Fletcher]. She was born 30 Oct 1771 in Wayne Co., NC⁴, and died 16 Nov 1807 in Wayne Co., NC⁵.

Children of David Peelle and Priscilla Fletcher are:

- 2 i. James⁸ Peelle, born 11 Nov 1794 in Wayne Co., NC; died Bet. 1832 - 1835 in Calloway Co., KY⁶. He married Elizabeth McCracken; born Abt. 1801 in NC⁷; died 1852 in Marshall Co., KY.
- 3 ii. Mary "Polly" Peelle, born 29 Aug 1796 in Wayne Co., NC⁸; died after 1829 in Wayne Co., NC. She married William Sanders Lancaster 09 Oct 1813 in Wayne Co., NC; born 20 Jun 1789 in Wayne Co., NC; died before 1866 in Wayne Co., NC.
- 4 iii. Robert Peelle, born 25 Feb 1801 in Wayne Co., NC⁹; died 28 May 1864, buried in Peele Cemetery, Scotland Co., NC¹⁰. He married Mary Adams Abt. 1823 in Marlboro, SC; born 09 Feb 1806 in Marlboro Co., SC¹¹; died 17 Apr 1895 in Peele Cemetery, Scotland Co., NC¹².
- 5 iv. Fletcher Peelle, born 14 Dec 1805 in Wayne Co., NC¹³; died 17 Nov 1883, buried in Pipe Creek Cemetery, Miami Co., IN¹⁴. He married (1) Asenath Nicholson 08 Mar 1827 in Sand Creek MH, Bartholomew Co., IN; born 16 Jan 1808¹⁵; died 21 Jan 1849, buried in Pipe Creek Cemetery, Miami Co., IN¹⁵. He married (2) Jane "Jenny" Stuckey 09 Mar 1851 in Bartholomew Co., IN¹⁶; born 01 Apr 1809 in Jennings Co., IN; died 27 Jul 1895, buried in Harmony Cemetery, Bartholomew Co., IN.

Upon the death of the parents, David's neighbor-brother Willis was appointed guardian to the children. They were in good hands; two Peelle brothers had married two Fletcher sisters and they lived on adjoining tracts of land. David's younger brother Willis-1763 married Priscilla's older sister Betsy Fletcher-1765. Willis was named the executor of Priscilla's estate and sold everything except the land in an estate sale on November 25, 1807. The land had been left to James. The sale brought a total of £267/17/0. Mrs. M. R. Mason, of Fremont, NC, sent me a copy of the guardianship appointments records which she retrieved from the North Carolina State Archives. Her papers contained a copy of the actual bond that Willis posted to become the guardian of James Peelle.

The final proof that there were two Davids is in the 1807 will of Robert-1730, who outlived his son David-1754. Grandfather Robert-1730 left one hundred silver dollars to his grandson Fletcher Peelle, son of David deceased. Fletcher was not named in David's 1800 will but was named in Priscilla's 1807 will. He was not born until 1805.

The following chart shows the names of all those who have entries in Geni.com. The majority of these have the birth date for David-1751 and the death date for David-1754 combined as shown in the two images above. I am sure that some of you know some of these folks. If you do, would you please contact them and let's get their records straight. Have them contact me and I will send them all the information they need to correct and/or complete the entries on Geni.com.
